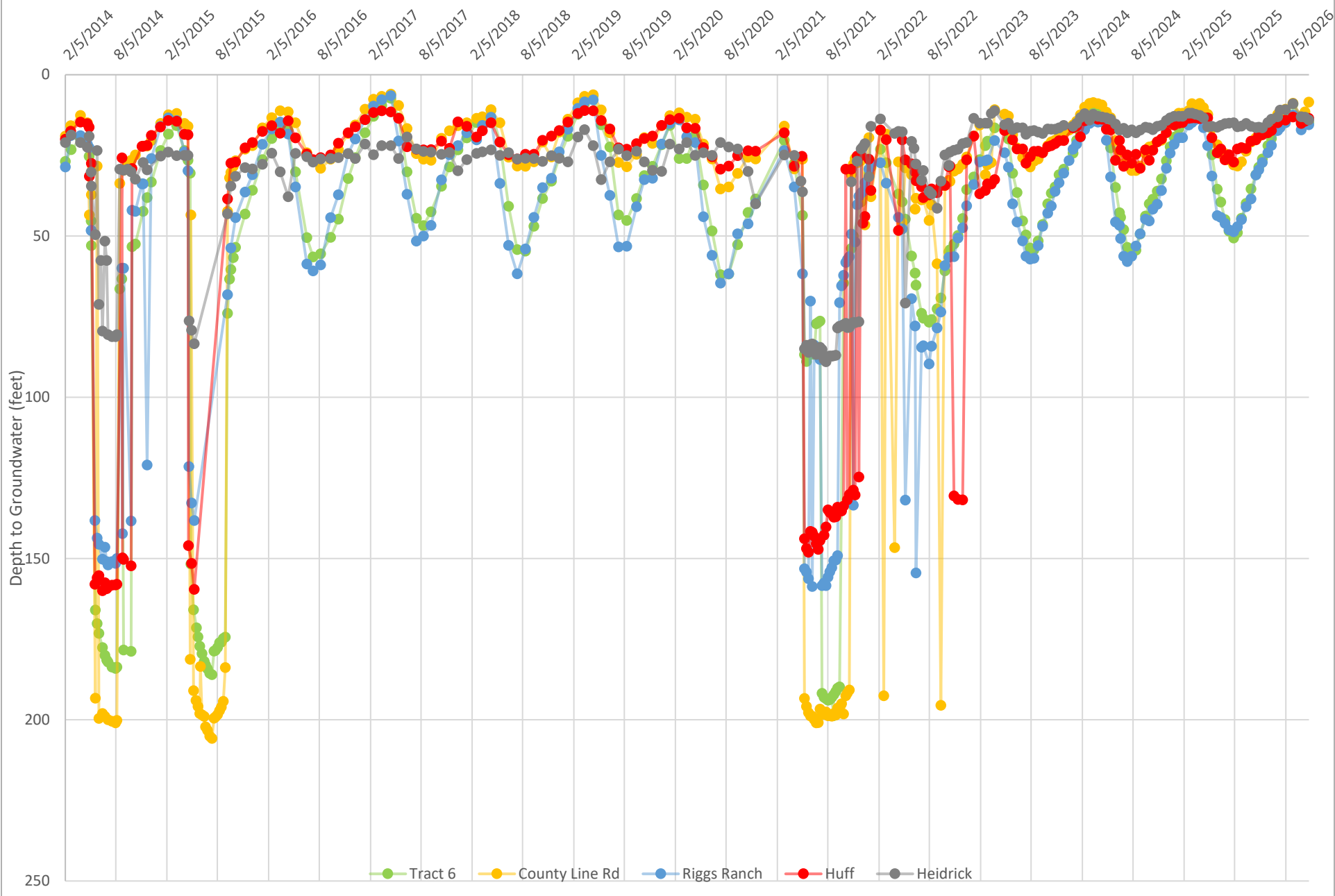
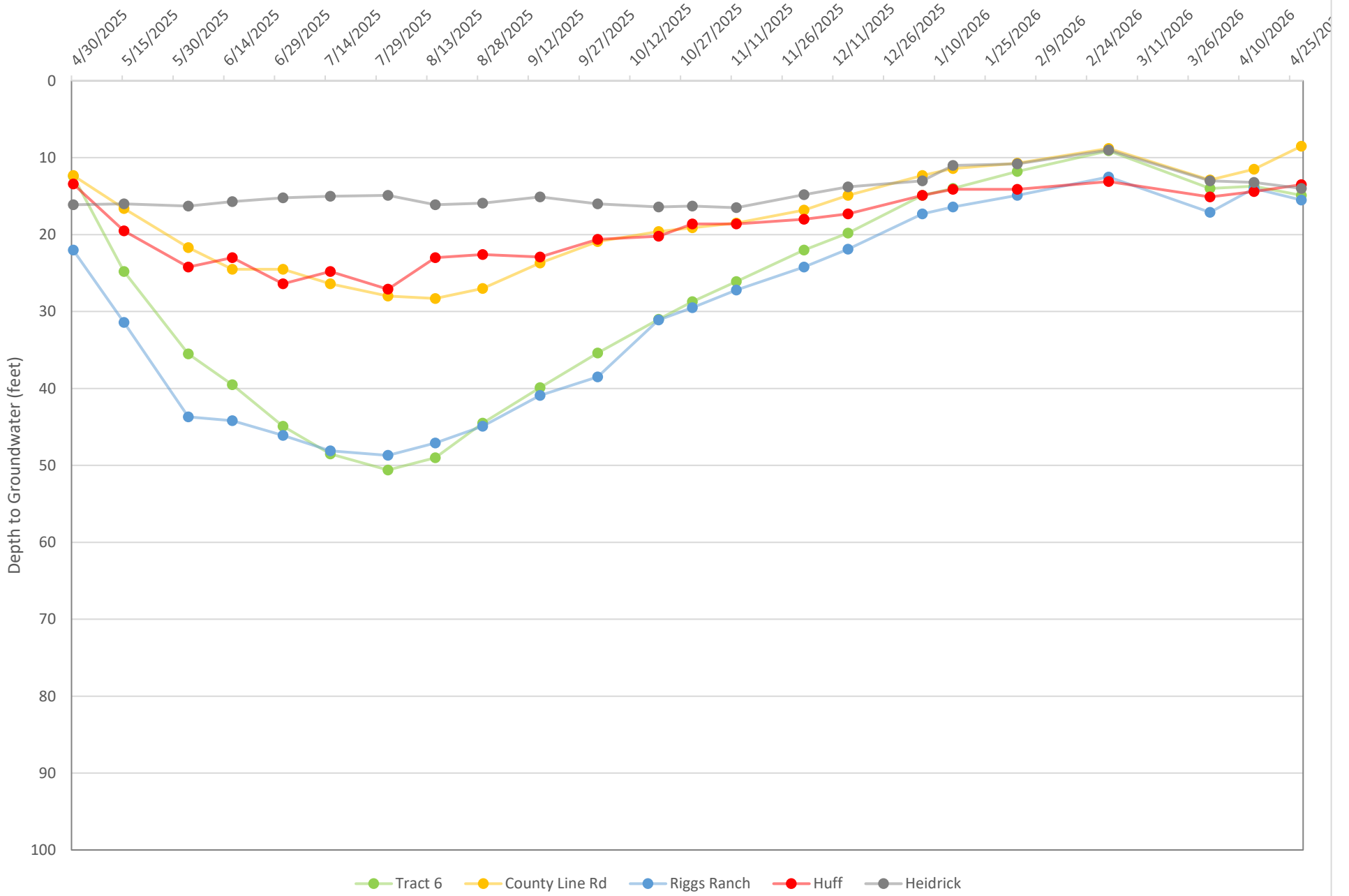


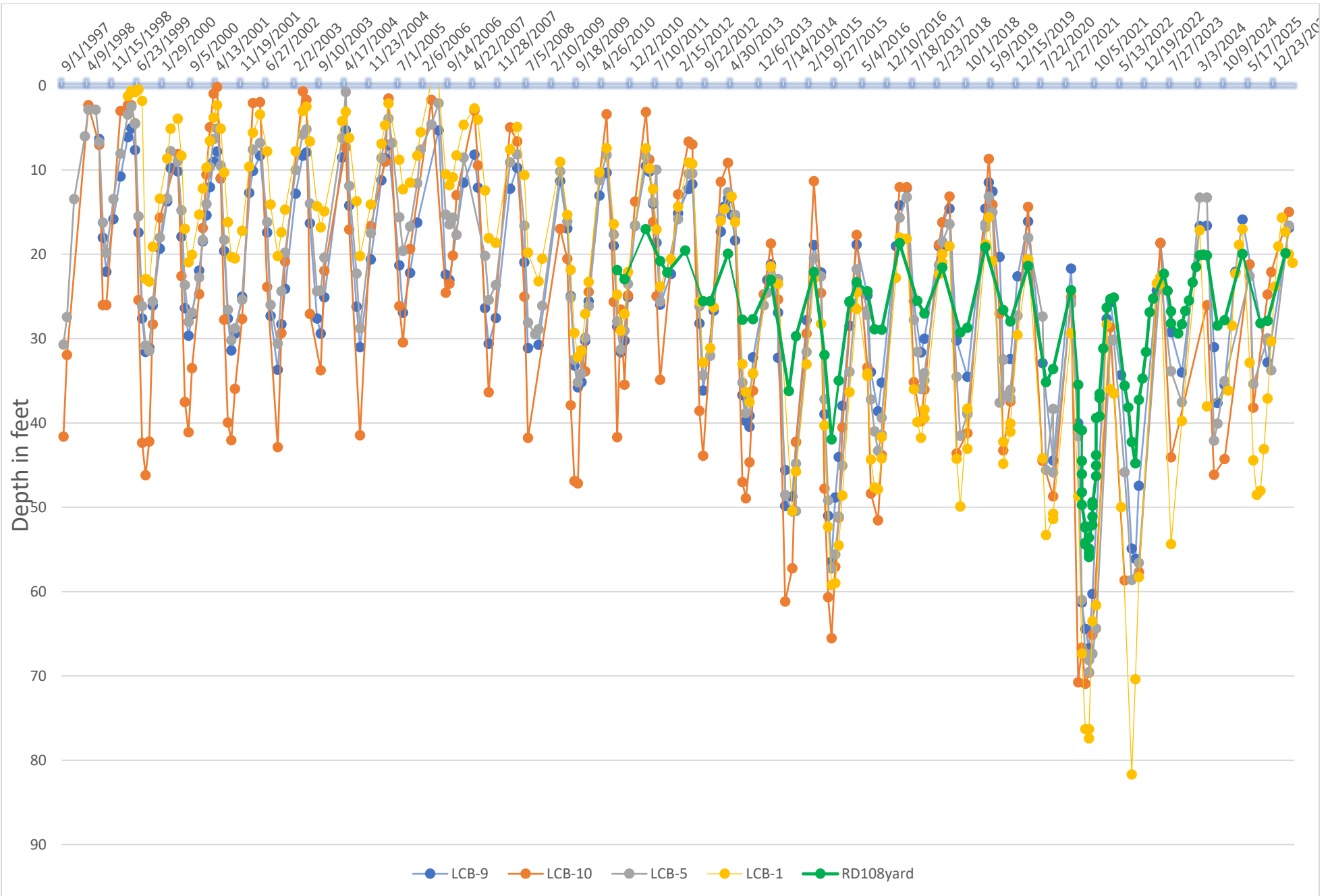
### District Wells - Historical Water Level Chart



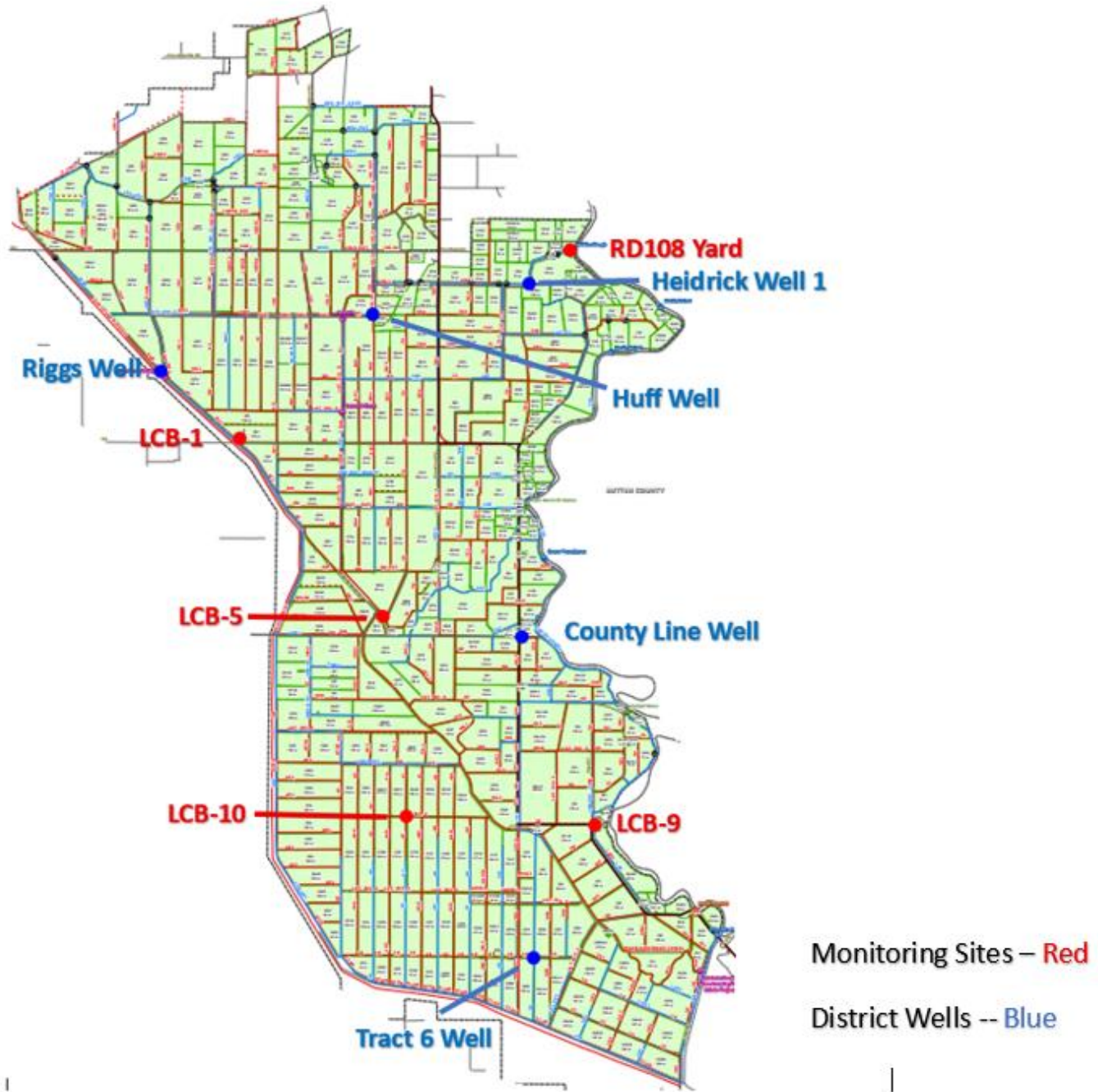
### District Wells - 1-Year Water Level Chart



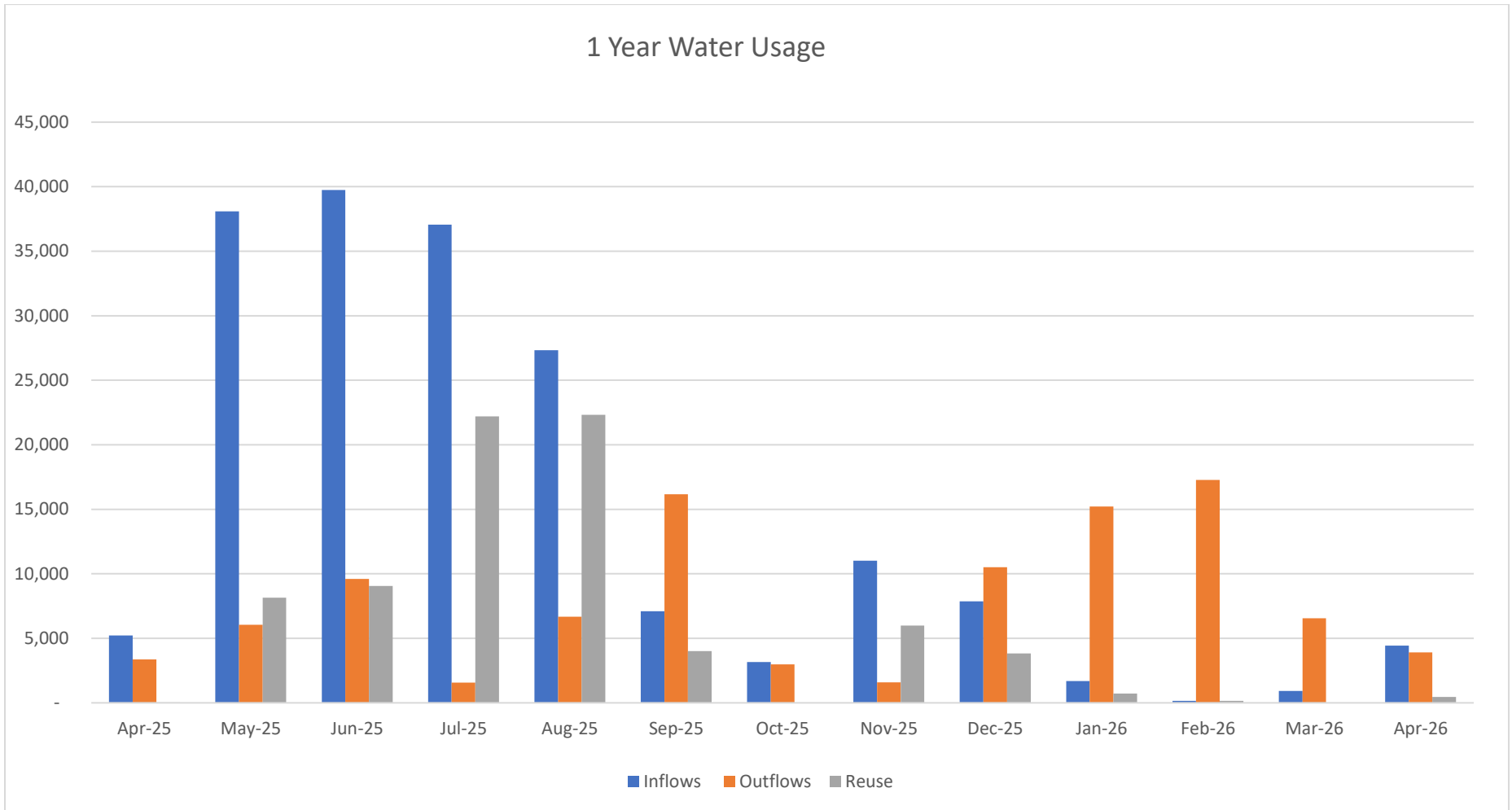

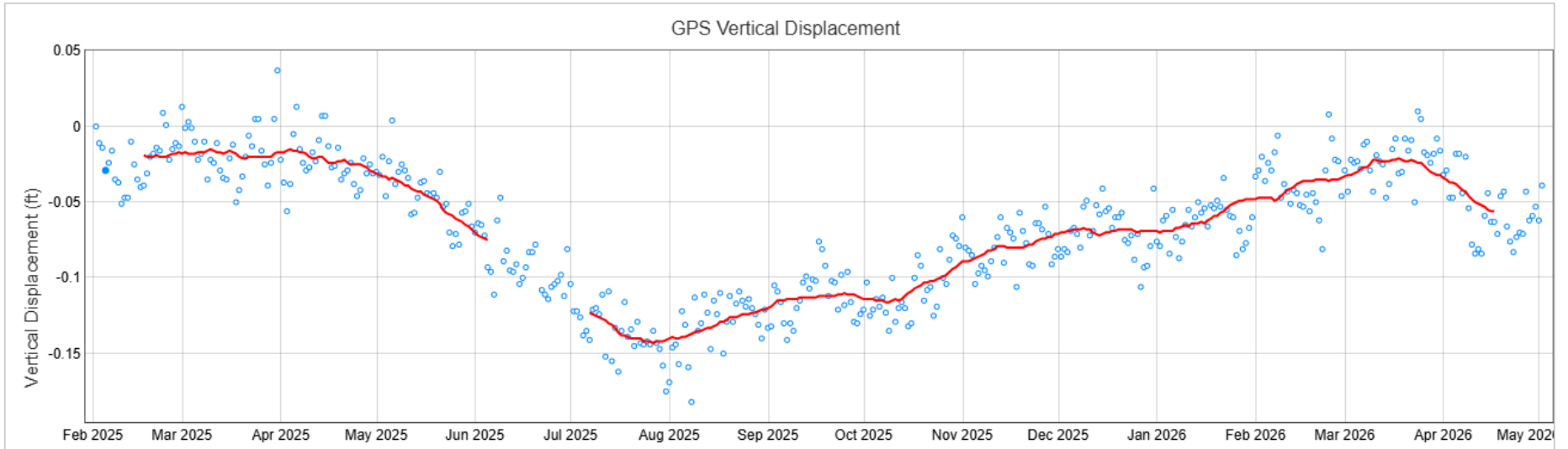

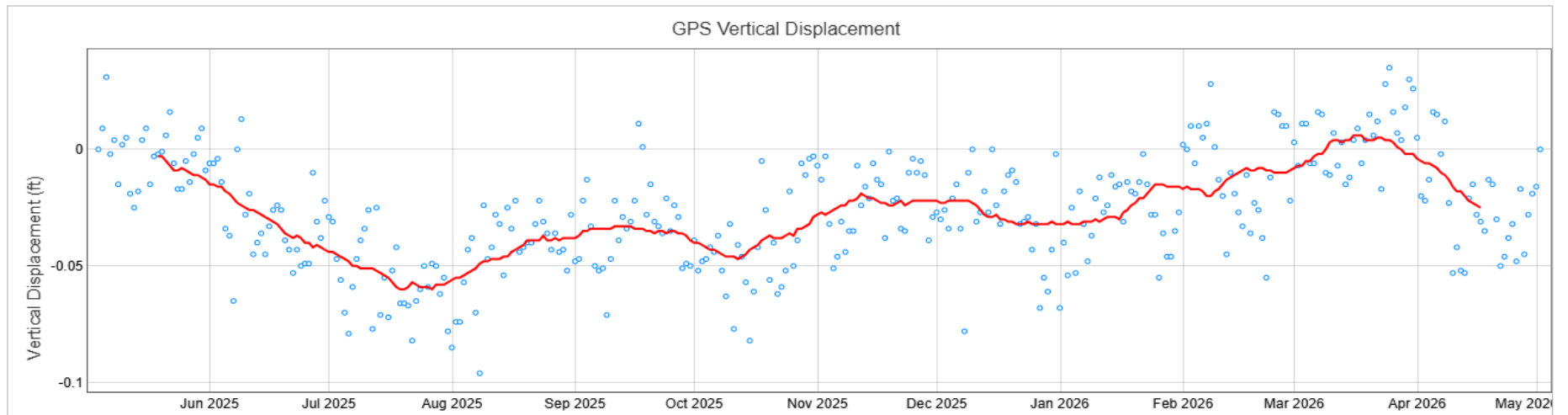
# RD108 Subsidence Stations

Station: Tract 6 Shop



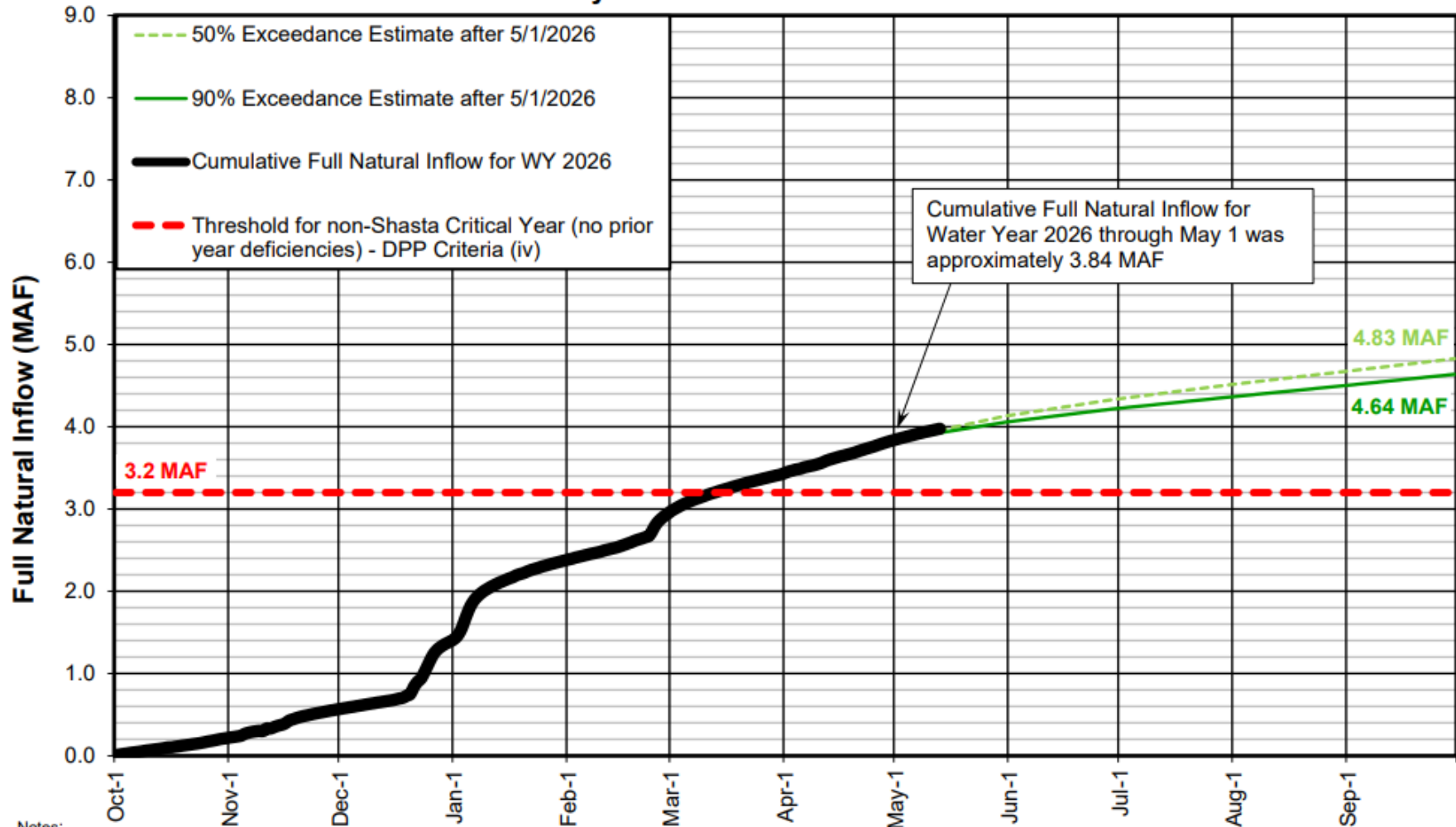
Station: Sycamore/Main drain

**Notes:**

1. Cumulative Full Natural Inflow is based on mean daily data obtained from the California Data Exchange Center (CDEC) for the Sacto Inflow-Shasta (SIS) station. Exceedance estimates are based on DWR's May 1, 2026 Bulletin 120 forecast for unimpaired inflow to Shasta.
2. Pursuant to the Drought Protection Program Agreement (DPP) between Sacramento River Settlement Contractors (SRSC) and U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR), additional contract shortages may occur when four criteria are met. Two of the four criteria, as shown in this figure, are based on inflow: (iii) combined actual and forecasted full natural inflow to Shasta Lake from October 1 through April 30 is less than 2.5 MAF and (iv) Reclamation forecasts a Shasta Critical Year under the Settlement Contracts.
